Day Activities

Tour and Cream Tea

Visit Pax Lodge for a morning or afternoon and have a guided tour of the centre. Also watch the WAGGGS DVD, play an international game or two and participate in a WAGGGS activity on the 2010 World Thinking Day theme of Hunger and Poverty.

Also included is a special Pax Lodge cream tea with scones, cream and cakes! There will also be an opportunity to visit the Pax Lodge souvenir shop.

Activities are offered between 10:30 to 12:30 or 14:30 to 16:30. To fully participate in all of the activities, please allow your group between 1½ - 2 hours.

The £5.00 activity fee includes the Pax Lodge pin and a donation to the World Thinking Day fund.

Visit to Crystal Palace Park and the Centenary Maze

Crystal Palace Park is a Victorian pleasure ground used for many cultural, patriotic and sporting events. Girlguiding UK's Centenary Maze is also located at Crystal Palace and is one of the largest in the UK. It was there during a Boy Scout rally in 1909 that a small group of pioneering girls approached its founder Robert Baden-Powell to demand 'something for the girls'. The rest is history...



Travelling by underground and train to Crystal Palace Park, enjoy a day outdoors. Explore the maze through a variety of teambuilding activities, venture through the dinosaur park and see the remains of Crystal Palace. This day activity will be leaving Pax Lodge at 10:00 and returning by 16:00.



Challenge around London

A challenge is set, but how will you perform? Can you work together as a team to complete everything on the list?

In smaller groups compete against each other in a race around London. Discover a hundred fun ways to experience London and the Girlguiding Centenary! There will be the option to choose the location of the challenge - Greenwich (Place of Greenwich Mean Time, 0° Longitude, Royal Observatory, Markets) or South Kensington museum area with Hyde Park (Science Museum, Natural History Museum, Harrod's and Hyde Park).

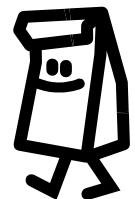
WAGGGS and the World
