When is the closing date for Razaam?

30th April 2017

Do girls have to attend with a Leader?

Yes, normal Girlguiding adult:child ratios apply. For Rainbows, this ratio is 1:5 and a minimum of 2 adults are required, irrespective of the size of the group. Young Leaders under 18 years old can attend but must not be counted in your ratios

Can Rainbow Helpers and Young Leaders attend?

Yes, providing they are registered on Go! as having that role

What time does the event finish so that I can book transport?

Units are free to leave at a time to suit them, but the event will finish around 4pm

What forms do I need to complete?

The necessary forms will be sent to the main contact on the application form for completion, upon receipt of the application form at Region HQ

Is Razaam suitable for members with disabilities?

Yes, all members of Girlguiding North West England are welcome to attend this event, but please do contact us to discuss any specific requirements

What are the catering arrangements?

Units can bring a packed lunch with them to the event. Alternatively, lunch vouchers for a packed lunch of a sandwich, piece of fruit and a drink are available to purchase via the application form. Hot food will be available to purchase on the day, a full menu will be distributed in advance of the event.

What time does Razaam start?

Girlguiding North West England members can arrive at Exhibition Centre Liverpool from 10am. Please note that entry will not be permitted before this time

What safeguarding measures will be in place?

Rainbows must be supervised at all times by their Leaders. All Rainbows and their Leaders will be asked to wear guiding wear so they can be easily identified. Volunteer staff will be around throughout the event to assist with security, in addition to security staff provided by the venue

Can I bring my friend and / or family member?

No, unfortunately this event is for Girlguiding North West England members only

Do we need to wear uniform/members' wear?

Yes, all those attending will need to wear the appropriate members' wear, or the official event t-shirt. The order forms for the t-shirts can be found on our website.



Does the cost include transport to the event?

No, transport to the event should be arranged separately. Please indicate on your application form how you plan to travel to the event

If arriving by car/coach/minibus, are there facilities for parking and will it cost extra?

The cost of parking at the event is not included in the ticket price but, if travelling by coach/minibus, this should be included in the quote from your chosen supplier

If travelling by car, the Liverpool Waterfront Car Park is adjacent to Exhibition Centre Liverpool and features 1,600 secure, covered spaces. There is a 2.1m maximum vehicle height for Liverpool Waterfront Car Park. Parking Tariffs are as follows:

- £7 for up to 5 hours
- £10 for up to 9 hours
- £15 for up to 24 hours

Is it possible to arrive via public transport?

Yes, the nearest train station is Liverpool Lime Street. Exhibition Centre Liverpool is a 20-minute walk from Lime Street, through the city centre, or a short taxi ride. You can also transfer at Lime Street onto the underground Wirral Line trains to James Street station (10 minute walk) or catch the CityLink Route C4 (7am - 8pm) directly to Exhibition Centre Liverpool. If travelling from outside Merseyside, your ticket includes an underground journey across Liverpool to James Street station from Lime Street station.

Who is responsible for first aid?

There will be a nominated First Aider on duty throughout the event. However, all Leaders should carry a first aid kit to use for their Unit in minor circumstances and all Leaders will be responsible for their own minor first aid incidents. In the event of a more serious incident, a member of the event team or a venue staff member should be contacted.

I am supposed to do a risk assessment, will this be available or should I write my own?

The event will be fully risk assessed by the organising team and the risk assessment will be available to view closer to the event, upon request. You should treat the event as any other event you would take your girls to, and your risk assessment should include your travel to and from the event.
