- No sharing documents

- Sharing ready-made videos
- Sharing live stream events

Zoom

- Limited interaction
- Everyone needs a Google account,
- To live stream via mobile you need 1,000 subscribers
- Can take up to 24 hours to set up

- Virtual backgrounds

- Age 16+ unless using a parent's account

- Video chat
- Up to 100 people
- Scheduling recurring meetings
- Screen sharing
- Access to Google apps
- Controlling who can join

Google Hangout

- You can only see 16 people on screen at once
- Everyone needs a Google account to join
- There's no virtual backgrounds

- Texting
- Sharing photos and videos

- No document sharing
