Q3 We have loads of fabulous football teams across the region, but which has won the most trophies? Manchester City, Manchester United, Liverpool or Everton?



Q4 Beatrix Potter the author of children's books, such as The Tale of Peter Rabbit lived in our Region, but do you know which County she lived in? Cumbria South, Lancashire East, or Cheshire Border?



Q5 There is one Zoo detailed on the map overleaf, but there is another famous Zoo in our region, can you tell us where it is? Lancashire East, Lancashire West or Stockport?




Q6 Which point on the map overleaf would you say is the most central? Girlguiding North West England Headquarters, Pendle Hill or White Nancy?




Q7 When walking around Bolton (Lancashire Border) what animals can be seen displayed as statues and on buildings? Lions, Tigers or Elephants?

Q10 One of our counties has the second longest pier - is it Blackpool, Cheshire Forest or Sefton?





Q14 One of our counties is famous for it's silk. Is it Greater Manchester West, Cheshire Border, Manchester or Cumbria North?




Q16 Bertie and Bella are two birds that look after citizens of which city in one of our counties? Lancashire West, Merseyside, Sefton or Lancashire Border?
