



Region President's Award

Girlguiding North West England

Applications for the Region President's Award are considered by the Region Awards Committee, which meets twice to three times per year.

How to Apply

A completed application form, accompanied by at least three supporting letters, should be returned to Region HQ, Guiding Road, Preston PR2 5PD

The letter need not be in formal style - it is more important for the writer to reflect the impact the nominee has had, without worrying about spelling or grammar (e.g. how she helped in an emergency, how she has worked to help others etc). These can be submitted by email. If you have any supporting evidence e.g. a local newspaper article etc., you can also include these.

All applications should be supported by a local Commissioner and County Commissioner.

Criteria

The nominee must be:

- A full active member of Girlguiding North West England
- Under the age of 18

The Committee is looking for someone who has gone the extra mile to deliver/do service which has created an impact in their community and beyond, wider than their Rainbow/Brownie/Guide unit, including:

- Helping in a local crisis
- Raising awareness of local issues/a charity other than Girlguiding
- Demonstrating exceptional initiative

Please note:

- When an award application is made as a result of support in a local crisis, this must have occurred within the last 6 months
- The Region President's Award can be awarded just once in your guiding life

The final decision of all applications is made by the Girlguiding North West England Awards Committee
