

## What's in the toolkit

As the new terms starts for guiding and girls are back to school, the Girlguiding central marketing team will be launching a targeted paid girl recruitment campaign. This campaign will be focussed on reaching prospective, interested parents and carers, looking for after school club options for their girls.

## What's happening and when

The central Girlguiding team will be launching a targeted paid girl recruitment campaign on 1 September 2023 until 30 November 2023. The campaign will run across TikTok, NextDoor, Google Search, and Performance Max.


### Campaign updates:


## Tips and recommendations


