The 2026 theme is Together for Good, reflecting a simple truth: when people come together in their communities, they create real, practical benefits - for local places, for nature, for climate and for our shared future 🌍

Run an activity with your unit:

- Go outdoors, discover nature and earn a badge using a RSPB Girlguiding activity pack: [Brilliant Birds](#) or [Together with Nature](#)
- Run a [craftivism](#) activity, make a green heart to wear or display to show you care about climate action. ❤️
- Share ideas on how you can take action to help nature and what you'd like others - such as the government - to do. You could write pledges for nature on [leaves](#) to make a 'tree of pledges', see this [article](#) for ideas to get you started. Choose one pledge from the tree to try out during the week and share what you did at your next unit meeting. Write to your local MP to call for further action on nature.
- Swap an unloved space for a wildlife habitat by planting things that benefit nature and bring beauty to the community. If you don't have access to much outdoor space, try [planting sunflowers](#) in pots or [growing food for moths](#) 🌻
